WITH PINGER ATTACHED - CURRENT VERY LIGHT SE - LARGE TRAP
LOADED WITH SHRIMP - SECOND TRAP BEHIND ABOUT 30 FEET -
CABLE LOOPS ON BOTTOM - PHOTOGRAPHED SHRIMP AT BOTH TRAPS.
POISONED PINK FISH TWICE. LOST 1ST ONE - GOT SECOND ONE
COLLECTED SMALL GRAB + BIG BLACK JEA SLUG IN SUCKER BASKET
LARGE STING RAY HOVERING AROUND TRAPS PLUS 2 BALLOON FISH
EXPERIMENTED PLACING PUNCTURED TUNA CAN IN VARIOUS PLACES
TO OBSERVE SHRIMP ATTRACTION. POWERED EAST TO 1150'
SURFACE WATER EXTREMELY TURBID
MADE ROUTINE RECOVERY
