REVERSED AGAIN TO SW AND RUST DOWN SLOPE TO 600' AND FINALLY  
TO 800'. CURRENT AT FIRST PART OF DIVE NE - 6 KNOTS. DIMINISHED  
TO 0 KNOTS AFTER FIRST RUN TO SW. REMAINED VERY LIGHT SW
