Coral rubble and sand bottom. Move up slope. Collecting corals with fish sucker.

Move back to shallow water, locate some large (4) steel grid structures, one with anchor and line attached.

Return to area of sand and light coral rubble. Deploy bouy. Surface. Make a normal recovery.
