Photograph and survey reef #1 then move NW to reef #4. Move to reef #3 after photographing #4. Photo and inspect reef #3. which is to the N.E. of #4.

Move south to reef #2. F.A.D. device was still on reef #2. Photograph and survey reef #2. Move North to survey reef. 1430 Leave the bottom from 320'.

Make a normal recovery.
