Basalt outcrops. Collecting echinoderms. Move up slope
to 500m. Investigating sandy patches in rocky terrain.
Collecting specimens. Move up to 300m. Discover an
absence of the preferred urchins at 300m. Move back
down to 500m. Very interesting terrain with areas of
thick sponge forests. Locate numerous Aspidodiadema.
Collect eleven total.
Leave the bottom from 475m. Make a normal
recovery. Two Sea Cliff personnel are diving with
LRT crew to observe and film recovery.
