Descend after 5min. of shooting. 0957 Land on a hard carbonate bottom in 356m. Begin moving to the NNW along a contour between 350m and 360m. Discover several Deepwater Black Coral trees. 1157 376m Discover a short vertical wall. Good terrain for pilot training exercises. Move to the south West to relocate the debris field for manipulator practice. Can not get a position from the surface. Move S.W. Leave the bottom from 526m
