Dive Results/Remarks: 0848 Lend on a hard bottom in 359m. Flat with Bamboo Corals, wire corals, and other gorgonians. Move to the South East, Moving upslope. Sub is heavy. Pump out water. On the flats at 336m moving S.E. 1006 Conduct first bait station over the edge at 354m on the South side. Continue down slope. 1053 Conduct deep bait station at 461m. Collect rocks. 1225 Conduct midposition bait station at a depth of 401m. 1318 363m Moving North. 1356 359m. Conduct 4th bait station along top of cliff where baryx were sighted. Some fish were seen here on the pilot training dives in this area. 1526 362m Conduct Equipment Deficiencies: 1526 Lost bait station at 362m. Sighted one large snapper. 1552 Leave the bottom from 362m. Make a normal recovery.
