Dive Results/Remarks: Fisheries Survey Dive. Conducting bottom transects and bait stations. 0842 On the bottom in 145m. Move south to the southern wall of the 2nd finger. Drop down wall to 401m. 0934 Begin transect to the West. 1008 End first transect contouring at 400m over a silt/sand bottom. 1049 Conduct bait station. 1050 Secure bait station. Move upslope to the N. to 350m. 1110 Begin transect to the East. Start in steep sand and mud terrain and get into steep carbonate wall with some overhangs. 1150 Move upslope to 300m. Encounter a large overhang. 1203 Transect West at 300m. 1256 Move up the wall to a depth of 250m. 1305 Begin transect to East. 1338 253m Set bait station. 1430 Secure bait station. Move upslope to 200m. 1448 Transect to the West at 200m. 1531 202m conduct another bait station along the cliff face. 1553 Secure bait station and leave the bottom.
