Dive Results/Remarks: 0839 Land on a hard carbonate bottom at 453m. Strong current running to the south. Collecting bits from red coral colonies. Pilot training dive. Fill port sample box with corals then change pilots so training pilot can get time handling the sub and collecting corals in starboard sample box. Collecting red corals at 458m. Collecting pink at 447m to 409m. Move down slope to the south. Collecting gold corals from 442m. Low angle carbonate bottom with boulders. Corals on boulders. Fill all collecting jars (15) with gold coral from 440m to 460. Discover several large gold coral trees on top of a pinnacle about 10m high in 461m. 1605 leave the bottom from 467m. Make a normal recovery.
