Dive Results/Remarks: Dive on alternate site due to rough sea conditions on primary sites. Pilot training and rock collecting. Search for evidence of submarine landslide. 1123 1767^m meters on the bottom. Land on a low angle sandy bottom. Moving south. Moving over sand and pillow basalt formations. Collecting rocks and animals. Begin moving to the South West. Move along steep intact pillow basalt formations. Do not discover an obvious exposed wall that would verify evidence of a submarine landslide. Leave the bottom from 1757^m.
