Pinnacle is 12m high. 1055 Locate another badly broken up landing craft. 1133 Moving East. 1204 357m Collecting cups. Manipulator practice. 1230 Move back to the West. 1344 366m Locate mid section of a type-A. Japanese Midget submarine. _____ Stern has been blown off. Laying 45° over to port. Bow section which contained torpedos is gone. A hole has been punched through the forward section of the mid body and has been rigged with a heavy cable. The sub was dumped. Get video and still images of sub. 1504 Leave the bottom. Make a normal recovery.
