Dive Results/Remarks: Conduct test and training dives in Pearl Harbor entrance defense area. 0930 On the bottom in 405m. Move East conducting sonar exercise to identify suspicious targets. Locate fields of dredge debris. 1014 403m At Pepe Hotel position Move upslope to the North to 397m. Locate the remains of an overturned truck. 1028 Moving west. 1045 391m at the top of a pinnacle with many gold coral trees and lines. Lines present a serious entanglement hazard. Several loose lines are streaming in the current.

Equipment Deficiencies: 1121 Reach west end of search. Continuing sonar exercise. Move to N.E. Move to 390m. 1215 Continue to move to the North West after completion of West track. 1215 Move to the N.W. to 383m 1222 Begin track to SW. 1300 End west search. 1309 N/E transit. Conduct sonar training exercise. 1608 Leave the bottom
