Move N. 0911 Move west at 429m 0959 404m Moved N to an old reef structure which is undercut and presents an overhang hazard when approached from the south. Some gold coral on old reef structure. Formation is approximately 11m high. 1019 414m Locate an old upright truck with spoked wheels. 1033 415m Locate the wreckage of a large sailboat. Name on stern, Kualoa. Moving ESE. 1042 Reach Eastern end of search. 1044 Move N. 150m. 1050 406m Moving west. 407m 1108 Locate a large barge. Several lines tangled on barge. 1147 Move N to position for Easterly Survey. 1157 392m Move East. 1246 386m Move West investigating sonar contacts. 1301 377m Locate a wing. 1405 362m line in midwater. Moved West. 1511 Moving N. 1559 348m Locate what appears to be hull of a Kingfisher float plane. (main hull float.)
