Dive Results/Remarks: Taking down sample crates with plastic jars to collect samples of precious corals. 0851 386m land on a barren sandy bottom. Poor visibility from 5m in water. Move to the South East towards intended dive position. Moving downslope over a barren sandy bottom with an occasional old reef outcrop. The area is not the type of terrain that supports precious coral growth. 0913 Scan area with sonar in all directions on 200m range. No solid contacts. 0915 Leave the bottom from 401m to relocate to another possible sampling site.
