Descend a steep wall to 138m moving south. 0941 226m Locate an old truck. 1042 Moving south. Locate piles of what appear to be decaying bundles of cable. 1054 421m Disintegrated wreckage of an old watercraft (steel) of some sort with numerous lines fouled on it. 1106 450m Locate a white cast iron bathtub. Continue to move South. 1235 Leave the bottom from 500m. Make a normal recovery.
