Dive Results/Remarks: Discovery channel filming dive. 0943 On the bottom at 387m 550m NE of midget sub. 1017 After pumping water from trim sphere begin moving to the SW. 1024 Stop to wait for PIV. 389m. 1032 PIV meets with PV, PV begins to move to SW. 1042 move to S at 391m. 1110 At the Midget sub. Move to the port bow. Experience camera problems with High definition camera 1140 move to the stern (stbd) of midget sub. Move up to midships stbd. side of midget to provide light for PIV After PIV leaves the site to return to surface we move to the bow (stbd.) and begin surveying the midget sub from bow to stern on starboard side and from stern to bow on the port side. We then position ourselves on a rock off the port quarter of the midget sub to provide lighting for PIV's second dive. 1819 Leave the bottom from 405m. Normal recovery
