Dive Results/Remarks: 0918 On the bottom at 1181m. 0920
Begin moving downslope to the SW. ¹⁰¹²⁹³ 1010 Begin moving upslope
to 1200m. 1030 Contour to the SE at 1210m. 1050 Come to
a basalt ridge approx. 2m high. The ridge extends approx
100m at 1218m depth. 1103 Deployed bait package,
amphipod trap and marker 23 at the top of ledge at 1218m.
1300 Begin moving to the south at 1218m. Stop several
times to photograph benthic organisms. 1340 Begin moving
to the north to relocate marker 23. 1418 Relocate
marker 23. Note that almost half of bait packages has
been consumed. 1430 Begin moving upslope to the east.
1500 At 1177m we trap a rock sample. 1505 Leave the
bottom from 1177m. Normal recovery.
