 surface tracking. 1005 Searching for "Whale Bone" site.
 Move to the NW. Questionable positioning, from surface tracking
 places the Pisces V 700^m to the NW of the bone site.
 Move to the South East. 1124 1061^m At bone site. Take
 still and video images of the whale bones. 1133 Leave bone
 site. Move to the SW to deeper water. 1206 Leaving the
 bottom from 1125^m. 1247 Make a normal recovery.
