craft at 325m. 1244 begin moving north. 1411 At
175m moving to the NE. 1425 At 138m locate
upturned aircraft. Have difficulty maintaining neg
buoyancy and unable to flood or pump water into trim tank.
1440 PIV in site. 1445 Begin moving to the SW. 1548 at
263m and stationary for PIV to track to us. 1613 Site
PIV and leave the bottom from 263m Normal Recovery.
