Divers in the water. 1015 Began descent. 1019 Land on a flat sandy bottom in 396m. North of midget sub. Move to the South East. 1044 406m at bow of midget sub. 1102 405m. Moved to conning tower area. 1217 408m Moved to stern then to the south away from sub to release weights. Leave the bottom from 408m. Make a normal recovery. Change observers and prepare Pisces V for a second dive. Pisces IV will launch after Pisces V.
