1014 Land on a sandy bottom in 1514<sup>m</sup>. Observe some  
ordnance on the bottom. Move to the WSW downslope  
to the dropoff. Locate a field of disposed mines and other  
ordnance. 1117 1650<sup>m</sup> at top of basalt wall. Begin  
descent down wall. 1145 At base of wall at 1900<sup>m</sup>. Descend  
a steep sandy slope to 1938<sup>m</sup>. 1204 Leave the bottom from  
1938<sup>m</sup>. 1340 On the surface. Make a normal recovery.

Equipment Deficiencies: Altimeter not operational. Upper camera goes out.
