Dive Results/Remarks: Two sub pilot training dive to conduct tracking exercises. Pisces IV launches first. 1001 Launch Pisces V. 1040 Land on a flat sandy bottom in 699m. Pisces IV had moved 120m East from this spot after landing. Pisces IV moves to the south while Pisces V gets trim sorted out. 1103 Begin first tracking exercise. Pisces V tracks Pisces IV on 27khz pinger rcvr. 1135 Locate Pisces IV. 718m. 1136 Pisces IV moves to the south. 1140 Pisces V moves to the SW to make distance from Pisces IV in preparation for starting second tracking exercise. 1225 Begin tracking exercise. Pisces IV is tracking Pisces V from a distance of 820m. 1302 Pisces IV Locates Pisces V. 1312 Begin a survey to the south to conduct pilot training.  
 Equipment Deficiencies: Pilots in training getting practice running subs. 1504 Pisces IV leaves the bottom from 912m. 1551 Leave the bottom from 856m.
