Dive Results/Remarks: 2 sub dive operations to survey the condition of the Japanese midget submarine as part of a documentary film with the SCUBANAUTS. 1020 Land on a flat sandy bottom in 402m. 1040 Move to the SE. Slight current out of the SE. 1052 Locate Japanese Midget Sub. 406m at stern of sub. Pisces IV is launched. 1127 Pisces IV is maneuvering around the Midget sub. Conduct sub to sub flyby maneuvers to get good video coverage. The Japanese Midget submarine is still intact and looks good. 1324 Pisces V and Pisces IV are moving to the south to explore new territory. 1500 Pisces IV leaves the bottom. 1602 Pisces V leaves the bottom from 485m.
