Dive Results/Remarks: 2 sub dive to survey the wreck of the I-401 and search for the I-400 and I-14. 0854 702m Land on a sandy bottom. 0903 Pisces IV is launched. 0911 Begin moving to the southwest towards the I-401. Covering new unexplored ground. 0944 Pisces IV is on the bottom. 1016 757m moving to the sw. 1100 811m On bottom near stern of I-401. Wait for Pisces IV to arrive. Move N to S over deck of I-401 from stern to conning tower. 1130 stable. Perched on edge of conning tower. Pisces IV moves from stern to collect video images. Pisces IV and Pisces V switch places. Pisces V collecting video of Pisces IV perched on conning tower. Pisces V moves aft to deck gun and lands on upper deck. Pisces IV conducts video survey around Pisces V and deck gun. 804m at deck gun. 1220 Pisces IV and Pisces V move to the south to search for I-400 and I-14. 1352 925m. Locate another torpedo. 1416 Pisces IV leaves the bottom. 1530 Leave the bottom from 1117m.
