 of tracking exercise P4 moves ahead to investigate contact. 1257 start tracking
 exercise #3, with P5 tracking P4 which is sitting on bow section of a large
 submarine wreck. 1329 747m on bow of large submarine, making observations.
1354 P4 moving WSW to investigate other targets. P5 to move E and then S.
1411 764m P4 reporting that they located main section of I-14 submarine.
 P5 to meet P4 at wreck site. 1456 768m stable on Goltow at stern of I-14.
