

1006 788m land on bottom in flat, sandy terrain. 1012 move NE toward I-14
 to make observations together with P4. After completion of observations,
 move to W, investigating star and side scan targets. 1130 commence
 last tracking exercise, P4 tracking P5. 1157 P4 "finds" P5. 1200 move
 SW to investigate side scan targets. 1231 812m move NE to investigate
 further side scan targets. 1323 812m locate a large torpedo. 1357 763m
 moving through I-14 debris field, ~~continue~~ continuing investigation of
 side scan targets. 1451 695m identifying last target as large outcrop.
1452 696m leaving the bottom. Normal recovery.
