0934 Land on a flat sandy bottom at 900m. Pisces IV is launching.
0944 Pisces IV passing 20m. 1005 863m moving WSW towards
 first contact. 1027 Locate wreckage of a badly decomposed landing
 craft. Survey wreck. Very hazardous. Heavy gauge floating lines and
 many upright steel beams. Site should be avoided. [REDACTED]
1015 Survey a second landing craft site to the south of the first wreck
 site. Another wreck to avoid. 1030 Pisces IV is on the bottom. 1038 Moving
 south. 1040 900m Locate a torpedo. Stop and use this position for tracking
 exercise. 1100 Begin tracking exercise. Pisces IV tracking Pisces V.
1120 Pisces IV locates Pisces V. 1143 Pisces IV moves south. 1215
 Begin tracking exercise. Pisces IV tracking Pisces IV. 1240 Locate
 Pisces IV. Both subs move S to wreck site. 1345 950m Locate the
 wreck of an LST at 950m. Pisces V surveys wreck. Survey bow still
 outfitted with AA and deck guns. Subs survey two sections of wreck. 1437
 Deploy tracking PDR near wreck. 1440 P-IV leaves the bottom. 1553 Leave the bottom from
 950m
