Dive Results/Remarks: 1027 Land on a sloping sandy bottom at 1527m.
Disposed ordnance all around. 1045 Move downslope to the West.
1130 1650m Moving to the WSW. Ordnance litters the bottom. Many
antitank-mines, MK9 & MK14 depth charges, 500lb bombs, MK6 & MK8
depth charges, mortar rounds, aerial bombs and aerial mines.
1155 1697m At drop off. Start descent down vertical
wall. Observe ordnance on wall. 1225 2000m at
base of vertical basalt wall on a steep sandy slope.
Disposed ordnance scattered around at the base of the
wall. 1234 Leave the bottom from 2000m. 1412 On the
surface. This dive concludes the 2010 ABS special
survey for Pisces V.
