Dive Results/Remarks: Test and training dive with Pisces IV and Pisces V. 1132 Landon a flat sandy bottom in 944m. Move to the SW towards target #1. 1127 Pisces IV is launched. 1202 Locate the wreckage of submarine S-4. Depth 952m. 1209 Pisces IV is on the bottom. 1229 Pisces IV begins emergency tracking exercise to locate Pisces V. 1251 Pisces IV locates Pisces V. End tracking exercise. Conduct Survey of wrecked submarine S-4. 1320 Pisces IV moves south to target #2. 1400 Begin emergency tracking exercise. Pisces V tracking Pisces IV. 1420 Locate Pisces IV near wreck of bow section of LST "Chittenden County". End tracking exercise. Pisces IV deploys transducer package for KOK tracking calibration exercise. Survey bow wreckage of LST. Pisces IV and Pisces V conducting filming tests with NetGeo Camera Systems. 1535 Pisces IV recovers xPDR and leaves the bottom. Pisces V moves down to the southwest. 1704 1451m Pisces V leaves the bottom.
