With time lapse camera is nearby. 0902 observe time lapse cam. 0912 begin search for
suitable piece of ordnance. 1009 locate suitable MK47A2 at 550m. 1300
sample suite: 13 sediment scoops, 1 box core, 1 shrimp trap, 1 brisling pl.
1300 sampling complete. 1315 search for ordnance following instructions
from surface science party. Report sightings of chemical and ~~cap~~
potentially explosive ordnance. 1540 565m moving through fairly dense
field of MK47A2 bombs. Counted 18 and had about 20 more on
~~some~~ SONAR. 1550 leave bottom from 565m. Normal recovery.
