Cable piles are up to 2m high and pose a serious entanglement hazard. 1000 549m Cable Monster. 1007 550m Cable Monster. 1010 550m Cable Monster. 1018 Move North. 1041 Another field of large steel buoys. 1105 557m Cable Monster. 1123 557m Cable Monster. 1131 557m Collect brizingsid on sandy bottom. 1135 Move to the West. 1142 556m Cable Monster. 1206 Locate Levens projectile. 1217 554m More steel buoys. 1219 Move East to wall. 1313 576m collect large orange brizingsid on sand. 1320 Continue to wall. 1336 619m at base of wall. Move up a steep carbonate wall. collect orange brizingsid off of wall. 1358 547m at top of wall. Move NE. 1408 547m locate two large hedgehog like bombs vertical in bottom. 1534 Leave the bottom from 546m.
