Dive Results/Remarks: Two sub dive to Wards Midget Sub.
1041 413m Land on a low angle sandy bottom in 413m.
1138 Locate midget sub. Pisces IV has landed near bow
of midget sub. 1200 417m at stern of midget sub.
Full moon current conditions. Light current but shifting.
Stern has settled more into the bottom. The flange joint
separation is wider and half of the screws and lower
stern have crumpled into the bottom. 1221 At conning
tower. Maneuvering around the midget sub with
Pisces IV and Pisces V, lighting and filming. Inspected
whole sub. Bow is still attached. Conning tower is
still intact. The current cycles completely around
the midget sub during the 3 hours both subs are
lighting and filming the wreck. 1556 Pisces IV leaves
the bottom
