Dive Results/Remarks: Two sub maritime heritage dive. Survey
of 3 piece midget sub. 0935 371m land on a flat sandy
bottom. Move south. 0957 Locate mid section. Survey mid section.
1014 Pisces IV on the bottom. 1030 Pisces IV arrives at midget sub.
1035 373m Deploy Colin Cam for view inside hole in fwd port side
of mid section to see if this sub was fitted with the Air & O2 bottles
specially fitted on the Pearl & Hr attack subs. View inside shows
batteries piled high in the hull. We do not have a clear view of
the air flasks, but discover that our view of the overhead is obscured
by something in a position where the tanks would be installed.
1115 Both subs move to the bow. 1250 Locate and survey bow
with both subs. Still in good condition. 1300 Subs moving
to stern section. 1320 At stern section. Survey stern
section. Decomposing. 1340 Subs moving to the NE. Search
for landing craft. 1415 Turn back to the SSW. PIV locates landing
craft. Filming. 1534 PIV leaves the bottom. 1630 Leave the bottom from 375m.
