1515 812m P4 & P5 move to the SW towards bow section.
1530 Pisces IV leaves the bottom. 1554 815m at bow section.
Move to broken section with AA gun. 1643 816m at hanger
section. Hanger door buried in bottom. 30' of hanger
standing upright with hanger door in bottom and hinge
exposed. AA gun intact still mounted to gun tub over hanger.
1657 Leave the bottom from 819m.
