Much ordnance on wall end at base of wall. 1130 Leave the
bottom from 2001m. Dump weights and ascend wall. Survey
wall as Piscos ascends. 1141 1800m ascending wall, 1203
1300m ascending. 1229 600m ascending. 1256 On the surface.
1313 Secure on deck. 1318 Hatch open.
