Scientific Data Acquired : Prepare an abstract outlining your objectives, techniques, findings, etc.

Chief purpose of dive was to inspect 1300 m. break in slope on Mahukona volcano to determine origin and age. Found 50 ft. thick beach deposits with associated sands containing shell fragments. This organic material can probably be radiometrically dated, thus defining when Mahukona volcano stood above the sea before its subsidence to the present level.

## MISSION EVALUATION:

Limitations, failures, or operational problems noted:

Failed to insure good video coverage of all samples before putting in basket.

Recommendations for corrective action or improvement:

Easily corrected by getting good video of each sample and transferring tape when leaving sub so that samples can be positively sorted out on return from dive site.
