A settlement tray was deployed at 460 m. on the north-eastern edge of Cross Seamount Summit. The deployment was followed by the geological mapping of the structure of the summit-flank break on the seamount. The summit is represented by a flat top covered by talus, rounded boulders and sediments. A thin manganese crust covers these rocks. Massive rock outcrops dipping vertically and representing dikes, marking the perimeter of the summit. The total landscape is dominated by the presence of debris. The dive depths varied between 420 and 460 m.
