Two ROV dives were used to survey the coral bed and adjacent habitant. The first dive was run from the bed out to the north extensions of the peninsula. No corals were found north of the bed. The second transit crossed the bed traveling south to north and indicated maximum dimension to be about 400m in length. One individual pinnacle was encountered 1000m south of the bed, which supported 2 moderate size gold corals.
