

One of the highlights of the visit to Honolulu was the visit to *Challenger* of King Kalākaua who arrived in a black frock jacket, white waistcoat and straw hat. According to naturalist Henry Moseley's account of this historic visit, "the King took the liveliest interest in the special work of the *Challenger*." King Kalākaua stayed aboard for lunch, then had his portrait taken with the ship's officers before returning to town.
