End User License Agreement Governing Commercial Computer Software and Commercial Technical Data Delivered With Seaglider Autonomous Underwater Vehicle

Introductory Note. The Seaglider Autonomous Underwater Vehicle (“AUV”) is a “commercial item” and is offered for sale and sold by Kongsberg Underwater Technology, Inc. (Kongsberg) under license from University of Washington. The computer software and technical data pertaining to, and delivered with Kongsberg’s Seaglider AUV is commercial computer software, commercial computer software documentation, and commercial technical data and is licensed to end users of Kongsberg’s Seaglider AUV under commercial terms and conditions.

BY DOWNLOADING, INSTALLING, OR USING THE SOFTWARE OR THE
SEAGLIDER™, YOU ARE BINDING YOURSELF AND THE BUSINESS ENTITY THAT
YOU REPRESENT (COLLECTIVELY, "CUSTOMER") TO THE AGREEMENT. IF YOU
DO NOT AGREE TO ALL OF THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT, THEN
KONGSBERG IS UNWILLING TO LICENSE THE MATERIAL TO YOU AND YOU MAY
NOT DOWNLOAD, INSTALL OR USE THE SOFTWARE OR KONGSBERG
SEAGLIDER™, AND YOU MAY RETURN THE ENTIRE PRODUCT FOR A FULL REFUND.
CUSTOMER'S RIGHT TO RETURN AND REFUND EXPIRES 30 CALENDAR DAYS
AFTER PURCHASE, AND APPLIES ONLY IF YOU ARE THE ORIGINAL END USER
PURCHASER.**



1. LICENSE DEFINITIONS.

A. “Materials” means computer software and its associated storage media, computer software documentation, as well as printed, on-line, or electronic technical documentation, and other related technical data, including any updates and upgrades thereto, that are customarily provided by Kongsberg with the Seaglider AUV to its commercial customers.

B. “Computer software” means the executable software code constituting the “surface” and onboard AUV software components of the Seaglider AUV system and any updates or upgrades thereto, that are provided by Kongsberg, directly or indirectly, during the term of this License Agreement. The term does not include computer source code and no rights to computer source code are granted under this License Agreement.

C. “Computer software documentation” means the documentation provided with the Seaglider AUV that explains the capabilities of the computer software or provides instructions for its use, including any updates or upgrades thereto, that are provided to end user by Kongsberg, directly or indirectly, during the term of this License Agreement.

D. “Technical data” means the information of a technical or scientific nature, including any updates or upgrades thereto, that is provided to end user by Kongsberg, directly or indirectly, during the term of this License Agreement and includes all such information provided to the end user by Kongsberg, whether as printed matter, electronic media, or through on-line Internet access.

F. “Licensee” means the end user of the Materials provided by Kongsberg under this License Agreement.

2. GRANT OF LICENSE. Kongsberg grants to the Licensee a non-exclusive, non-assignable, non-transferable license to use the Materials, under the terms and conditions stated below.

(i) Technical data.

(a) With respect to technical data provided as part of the Materials governed by this License Agreement, the Licensee has the right to use, modify, reproduce, release, perform, display or disclose such technical data, in whole or in part, but only within the end user’s organization.

(b) The Licensee may not, without the written permission of Kongsberg, release or disclose the technical data outside their organization, use the technical data for manufacture, or authorize the technical data to be used by another party.

(c) These restrictions do not apply to technical data that has been provided by Kongsberg to the public without restriction, such as certain form fit, and function data, and technical data necessary for operation, maintenance, installation or training.



(ii) Computer software. With respect to computer software and firmware (collectively referenced as “software”), provided as part of the Materials governed by this License Agreement, the Licensee has the right to:

(a) Use the Seaglider basestation computer software with an unlimited number of computers.

(b) Use the AUV onboard software installed in the Seaglider AUV solely with and for the AUV into which it was loaded by Kongsberg for delivery;

(c) Make the minimum number of copies of the computer software required for safekeeping (archive) or backup; and

3. GENERAL LICENSE RESTRICTIONS.

Licensee may NOT:

(i) use or copy the Materials except as provided in this License Agreement;

(ii) transfer or sublicense the Materials to any third party;

(iii) assign this License Agreement or the rights and obligations specified herein, without the express written consent of Kongsberg;

(iv) modify, adapt, prepare derivative works, or translate the Materials in whole or in part except as expressly provided in this License Agreement;

(v) reverse-engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Materials, except to the minimum extent required and for the specific purposes permitted under Article 2(ii)(e) above;

(vii) distribute, sublicense or transfer any components of the Materials and derivatives thereof to any third party.

4. COPYRIGHT. The Materials are subject to copyright owned by Kongsberg, its suppliers or licensors, and are protected by United States copyright laws, international treaty provisions and other intellectual property laws. Licensee will not remove any copyright, trademark or patent notice from the Materials. Licensee agrees to prevent any copying of the Materials except as expressly authorized by this license Agreement. Except as expressly provided herein, Kongsberg does not grant any express or implied right to user under Kongsberg or its licensors' patents, copyrights, trademarks, confidential or proprietary information.

5. REPLACEMENTS. The Materials are provided “AS IS” without warranty of any kind. If the media on which the Materials are furnished are found to be defective in material or workmanship under normal use for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of receipt, Kongsberg's entire liability and Licensee's exclusive remedy shall be the replacement of the



media. This warranty is void if the media defect results from accident, abuse, or misapplication by the Licensee.

6. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY. Except as provided in Article 5 above, Kongsberg offers no warranty, either express or implied, including those of merchantability, non-infringement of third-party intellectual property, or fitness for a particular purpose, nor that the Materials are free of bugs, viruses, worms, Trojan horses, imperfections, errors or omissions. Neither Kongsberg nor its suppliers or licensors shall be liable for any damages whatsoever (including, without limitation, damages for loss of business profits, business interruption, loss of business information, or any other loss) arising out of the use of, or inability to use the software, even if Kongsberg has been advised of the possibility of such damages. Because some jurisdictions prohibit the exclusion or limitation of liability for consequential or incidental damages, the above limitation may not apply to the Licensee.

7. UNAUTHORIZED USE. The Materials are not designed, intended, or authorized for use in any medical, life-saving or life-sustaining systems, or for any other application in which the failure of the Materials could create a situation where personal injury or death may occur. Should the Licensee purchase or use the Materials for any such unintended or unauthorized use, the Licensee shall inform Kongsberg of such intention prior to purchase, if possible, but in any event, prior to use in such an application. Upon receipt of such notification, Licensee agrees to negotiate with Kongsberg to determine the terms, if any, under which Kongsberg would be willing to accept such additional risk. If Licensee and Kongsberg cannot agree to such terms, Licensee agrees to forego any such unauthorized use of the Materials.

8. LICENSEE SUBMISSIONS. Licensee agrees that any computer software or technical data relating to the Materials, information or other communication, including all data, images, sounds, text, and other things embodied therein, transmitted or posted to a Kongsberg website or otherwise provided to Kongsberg ("Communications") will be considered and treated by Kongsberg as non-confidential. Licensee agrees that Kongsberg will have no confidentiality obligations or restrictions from disclosure with respect to such Communications. Licensee also agrees that Kongsberg and its officers, subsidiaries and affiliates and other designees will be free to copy, modify, create derivative works, publicly display, disclose, distribute, license and sublicense through multiple tiers of distribution and licensees, incorporate and otherwise use the Communications, including derivative works thereto, for any and all commercial or non-commercial purposes.

9. TERM AND TERMINATION. This License Agreement becomes effective on the date Licensee accepts the Kongsberg Seaglider AUV system and will continue in effect in perpetuity unless terminated as provided in this License Agreement. End User may terminate the Agreement and the license at any time by destroying all copies of Software and any



Documentation. If Licensee is using the Materials under the control of an Evaluation License, this License Agreement terminates at midnight, Pacific Standard Time, on the last day of the evaluation period which is specified in the Materials. If Licensee is in material breach of any of the terms and conditions specified herein, Kongsberg may initiate appropriate legal action to terminate this License Agreement and obtain other appropriate relief at any time after discovering such material breach. The waiver by either Party of any default or material breach of any provision of this License Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of any other or subsequent default or breach.

10. EXPORT RESTRICTIONS. Licensee acknowledges and agrees that the Materials are subject to U.S. export restrictions. Licensee shall comply with such laws and regulations governing export, re-export, transfer and use of Kongsberg Seaglider AUV Software and Technology and will obtain all required U.S. and local authorizations, permits, or licenses. Kongsberg and Licensee each agree to provide the other information, support documents, and assistance as may reasonably be required by the other in connection with securing authorizations or licenses. Licensee agrees, and warrants that neither the Materials nor any direct or indirect derivative thereof is being or will be acquired, shipped, transferred or exported, directly or indirectly outside the United States or the end user's country and that Materials will not be used for any purpose prohibited by U.S. export restrictions. Licensee agrees to require any recipient of the Materials under the terms of this License Agreement to indemnify and hold harmless Kongsberg and its officers, subsidiaries and affiliates against all claims, costs, damages, and expenses, and reasonable attorney fees arising out of, directly or indirectly, any improper export of the Materials or derivatives thereof made by such recipient or occurring as a result of any act or failure to act by such recipient.

11. APPLICABLE LAWS. This Agreement is controlled by and construed under the laws of the State of Washington, United States of America, notwithstanding any conflicts of law provisions; and the state and federal courts of Washington shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising under the Agreement. The parties specifically disclaim the application of the UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may seek interim injunctive relief in any court of appropriate jurisdiction with respect to any alleged breach of such party's intellectual property or proprietary rights. If any portion hereof is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. The Agreement has been written in the English language and the parties agree that the English version will govern. If any provision of this License Agreement is found unenforceable pursuant to a judicial decree or otherwise, the offending provision shall be stricken or rewritten in accordance with the requirements of the law or the mutual agreement of the Parties hereto, and the remainder of this Agreement shall be valid and enforceable.

12. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS.

(i) The provisions of this License Agreement shall be binding upon, and inure to the benefit of, the Parties hereto, their successors, and their permitted assigns.

(ii) This License Agreement may be modified or supplemented by mutual agreement of the Parties hereto, and which shall be contained in a written amendment to this License Agreement which has been and executed by an authorized representative of each Party.
